





1509 McKenzie Alder Bookcase Corner Connector — Assembly Instructions

Tools Required: Phillips Screwdriver, Pencil, Rubber Mallet or Padded Hammer



1. Move the bookcase with the attached Cleat (D) and align the predrilled holes in the cleat with the predrilled holes in the side of the second bookcase. Attach using #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws (E). See Figures 1 and 1a.



2. Making sure the pocket-drilled holes face up, align the holes in the Lower Corner Brace (A) to the predrilled holes in the sides of the bookcases. Attach with four #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws (E). See Figure 2.





3. Making sure the pocket-drilled holes face up, align the holes in the Upper Corner Brace (B) to the predrilled holes in the sides of the bookcases. Attach with four #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws (E). See Figure 3.

4. Position the Top (C) on the Upper Corner Brace (B). See Figure 4. Attach with four #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws (E). See Figure 4a.
